
## Hampton Roads 2045 Long-Range Transportation Plan StoryMap

The current Long-Range Transportation Plan (LRTP) for the Hampton Roads region, which was developed collaboratively with regional stakeholders and the public, has a planning horizon year of 2045 and was adopted by the Hampton Roads Transportation Planning Organization (HRTPO) Board on June 17, 2021. In efforts to enhance public engagement through visual storytelling, the Hampton Roads 2045 Long-Range Transportation Plan StoryMap was recently created to provide an overview of the LRTP process.



## Map of the Month – Population Mobility in Hampton Roads

How many people moved into a given area within the past year? The US Census Bureau asks this question in its American Community Survey (ACS), an on-going, annual survey used to learn about the nation and its population. ## **Project of the Month: Deep Creek Bridge Replacement project, City of Chesapeake**


